



Neighborhood Watch Resident Responsibilities

Call 911 to report any suspicious activity or crime in our subdivision.

Block captains have volunteered to help you as residents and our community maintain a safe and secure neighborhood.

Here is when you should contact your Block Captain:

- Let Block Captain know if you report any suspicious activity or crime to the police so they can inform other residents.
- Notify of solicitors in area that aren't permitted to solicit. You should ask solicitor if they are permitted and if they are not, let them know they have leave.
- If you see resident doing something unsafe, please talk with resident first and if you continue to see issues, let block captain know.
- Provide ideas of how to make our neighborhood more safe
- Let them know you want to join our Neighborhood Watch Program!

Ways to protect yourself:

- Add motion lighting to outside of your house
- Lock car doors even when car is in garage
- Let neighbors know when you're on vacation
- Install video camera or video doorbell

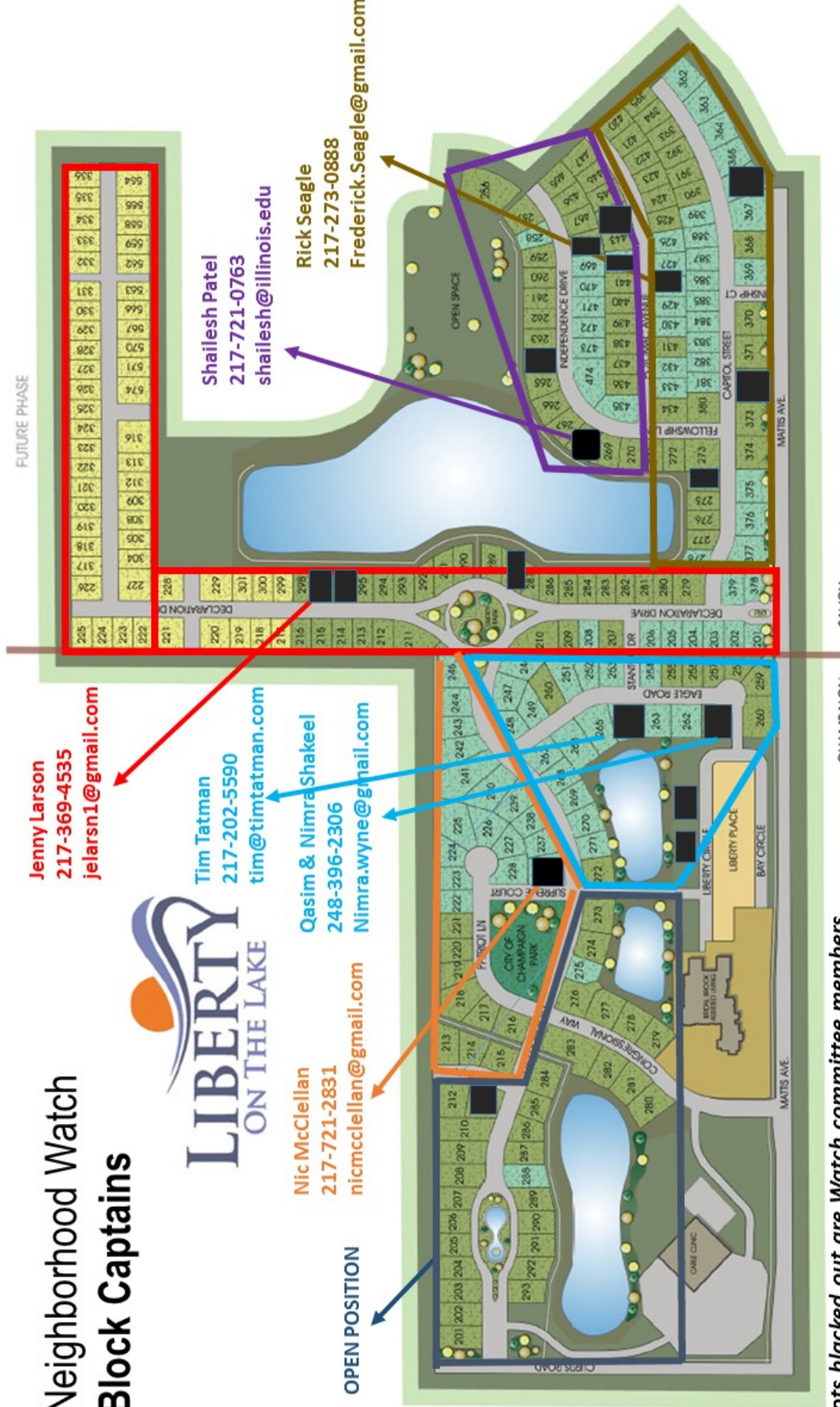
