## Trash & Recycling

Yard Waste Pickup – varies by city. Yard waste collection bags can be purchased at local stores.

- **Champaign** sponsors two seasonal yard waste collections during the year (one in spring and one in fall) and a Christmas tree collection for all residential properties in the City. Check the city website for dates.
- **Savoy** does not offer yard waste pickup, but weekly trash collection services offer pickup of bags for a fee. Yard waste can be taken to the **Landscape Recycling Center** (<http://www.landscaperecyclingcenter.org/>), a non-profit facility located in north Urbana serving Champaign County, for a fee.
